Introduction

CARE Egypt is hiring a Chief Executive Officer (CEO), which represents the highest-ranking executive in the organization and acts as the main point of communication between the Board of Trustees (BoT) and the executive management team as well as the key connector with CARE International. S/he co-develops and leads CARE's strategy and operations of the foundation in Egypt towards CARE's vision of "Envisioning an Egypt where everyone enjoys economic opportunities, equality, and social justice in their lives" and drives for impacts that benefit women and girls, address injustice and discrimination, and enhance the lives of poor and vulnerable communities.

The CEO is responsible for overseeing the development, funding, and implementation of the CARE Egypt strategy and a program portfolio (including emergency programming) that effectively addresses the underlying causes of poverty in line with CARE's programming principles. S/he must also ensure that all systems are in place and being properly implemented to ensure the effective, efficient, and successful management, well-being, and safety of CARE staff and the proper stewardship of CARE resources. The CEO is responsible for promoting gender equity and diversity and ensuring an organizational culture where CARE core values—excellence, integrity, diversity, learning, and equity—are practiced, teamwork is encouraged, and all staff feel valued. He or she is responsible for establishing and maintaining good working relationships with government officials, donors, and other partners.

Objective of the Assignment:

Hiring a recruitment agency to support in recruiting the new Executive Director for the foundation.

Recruitment agency 's Qualifications:

Deep understanding of the non-profit sector: Experience placing Executive Directors in NGOs: The agency should have a proven track record of success in the non-profit sector, understanding the unique challenges and opportunities of NGOs.

Strong focus on mission alignment and cultural fit: The agency should be able to articulate a genuine understanding of the foundation's mission, vision, and values.

Cultural assessment skills: Beyond technical skills, the agency should be able to assess a candidate's cultural fit with our foundation. This includes evaluating the leadership style, communication skills, and ability to work collaboratively with a diverse team.

Access to a diverse pool of talent: The agency should have a network of qualified candidates with experience in the non-profit sector. They should be able to identify candidates from a variety of backgrounds and perspectives.
