Hiring CARE Egypt Chief Executive Officer (CEO), this position is the highest-ranking executive in the organization and acts as the main point of communication between the Board of Trustees (BoT) and the executive management team as well as the key connector with CARE International. S/he co-develops and leads CARE's the foundation's strategy and operations of the foundation in Egypt towards CARE's that translates its overall strategic direction vision of "Envisioning an Egypt where everyone enjoys economic opportunities, equality, and social justice in their lives" and drives for impacts that benefit poor and marginalize groups, with a special attention to youth, women and girls, address injustice and .discrimination, and enhance the lives of poor and vulnerable communities

The CEO is responsible for overseeing the development, funding, and implementation of CARE Egypt foundation strategy and a program portfolio (including emergency programming) that effectively addresses the underlying causes of poverty in line with CARE's programming principles. S/he must also ensure that all systems are in place and being properly implemented to ensure the effective, efficient, and successful management, well-being, and safety of CARE staff and the proper stewardship of CARE the foundation resources

The CEO is responsible for promoting gender equity and diversity and ensuring an organizational culture where CARE the foundation's core values—excellence, integrity, diversity, learning, and equity—are practiced, teamwork is encouraged, and all staff feel valued. S/He or she is responsible for establishing and maintaining good working relationships with government officials, donors, and other partners.

Consultant's Qualifications:

Deep understanding of the non-profit sector:

Proven experience and track record for supporting local and international NGOs and Foundation in identifying potential candidates and shortlisting of potential CEO candidates, the agency is expected to demonstrate a proven record understanding the unique challenges and opportunities of NGO and foundations employment market and environment

Strong focus on mission alignment and cultural fit: The agency should be able to articulate a genuine understanding of the foundation's mission, vision, and values, to be used in reaching out and identifying relevant and potential applicants.

Cultural assessment skills: Beyond technical skills, the agency should be able to assess a candidate's cultural fit with the foundation. This includes evaluating the leadership style, communication skills, understanding and applying its core values and ability to work collaboratively with a diverse team.

Access to a diverse pool of talent: The agency should have a network of qualified candidates with experience in the non-profit sector. They should be able to identify candidates from a variety of backgrounds and perspectives.



Utilization of specialized assessment tools: Beyond traditional resumes and interviews, the agency should use psychometric testing, leadership assessments, and simulations to evaluate candidates' skills, abilities, and cultural fit, the assessment tool should be shared with the BIT for review and relevance clearance

Client testimonials and references: Ask for references from previous clients and inquire about their relevant experience which is aligned with the foundation CEO TOR.

Team composition and expertise: The agency should provide a list of the team who will be leading the process, whom should have proven track record in similar tasks and sub-tasks.

This technical proposal shouldn't exceed 5 pages, which should reflect the agency understanding of the mission, its plan, a reflection of its current capacity (# of current roster applications, # of similar tasks, # of Similar previous clients...etc.) list of deliverables and timeframe. The agency can include a separate annex Where needed to support its technical proposal, which shouldn't exceed 6 pages

2. Financial Proposal:
